A N O R D I N A N C E

authorizing the annexation to the City of Cleveland of a certain portion of Shaker Township.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND, STATE OF OHIO, That,

Section 1. The following portion of Shaker Township adjoining the said City of Cleveland be and the same is hereby authorized to be annexed to said City, to-wit: -----

Situated in the Township of Newburg, now the Township of Shaker, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, being part of Original Lots Nos. 418, 419, 420, 412 and 411 of said Newburg Township, and further described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Fairmount Road with the westerly line of said Original Lot No 412;

Thence from said point of beginning easterly, along said center line of Fairmount Road to a point which is distant easterly 265.0 feet, measured at right angles, from the center line of Rice Avenue, now known as East Boulevard;

Thence southerly, parallel with and distant 265.0 feet easterly from said center line of East Boulevard, to the northerly limits of the City of Newburg;

Thence westerly, but along said northerly limits of the City of Newburg, to the easterly limits of the City of Cleveland;

Thence northerly and easterly, but along the limits of the City of Cleveland, to the place of beginning.

Section 2. That the City Solicitor be and he is hereby authorized to apply to the Commissioners of Cuyahoga County, Ohio, to take such steps as may be necessary to cause the annexation of said territory to the City of Cleveland.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and legal publication. -----
